FAMILY 2 DEAF CHILDREN: EBENEZER + BUELAH 5 hearing
m. Patience Bourne widow of Joseph Allen
b. 1686 d. 1765 his deaf in-law - his hearing son - also named 9th selectman
served as selectman

(m. 11 Dec. 1683) with his 4 elder children
His will 23 March 1736 probated 30 Oct 1738 (Banks Vol III)

1694 bought land which became known as
Lambert's Cove
mentioned in Samuel Sewall's diary in 1714
